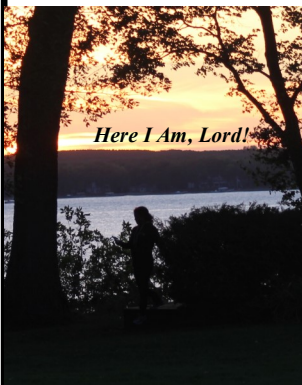

"Abuse Resource Network (ARN) is committed to meeting the needs of victims of domestic violence and sexual assault in a non-judgmental, empowering manner. We offer alternatives to them and support in following through on their own choices. Pr. Tammy will also bring Gudrun Wikklund from Sweden as a guest speaker.

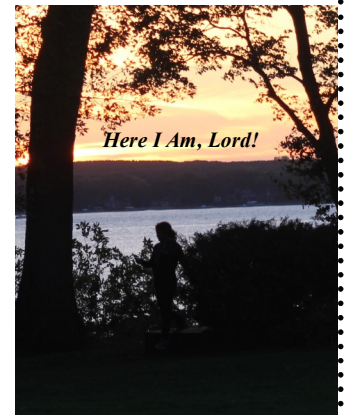
